

# White Crag Supplement – White Crag Right

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## White Crag Right

A single boulder of the roughest, silver, grit. It lies well right of the main groups at White Crag and just right of the recent amateur quarrying efforts. Keep a low profile as this is closer to the farm house than the other bits of the crag – **remember that this is not access land**. It must be assumed that it has been climbed on before but the roughness implies that it has seen little action.

### **1/ Right End Dyno** 5+

Boing from the break to the top.

### **2/ Place of Dragged Stone** 4

Ascend the sidewall from a low start and the good hold in the crack.

### **3/ High Arête** 4 (HS)

Step off the boulder and carefully climb the arête above the boulder jumble.

*Move around to the front for the main events:*

### **4/ Prime Arête** 4+

Take the high arête on its right from an easy sitter (this is much the same from a standing start).

### **5/ Silsden Tower** 5

Sit start, just right, off huge undercuts and reach up the wall. No arête holds.

### **6/ Tower Bridge** 6a+

Sit start from the same undercuts. Make a brilliant span right to the good crescent hold before taking in the wall.

### **7/ Prime Route** 5

The wall from standing. At pretty much any point.

### **8/ This is Cobbydale** 6a

Sit start from undercuts directly below the crescent hold. Climb the wall using cracks and whatever comes to hand.

### **9/ The Cobbydale Eliminate** 6a+

As before but eliminate the crack holds.

### **10/ Flaky Wall** 5

The flakes at the right end of the wall.
