# Pipe Boulder – Lower Quarry, Baildon Bank

Landings	Generally good. The shelf behind the trench the boulder sits in needs careful padding.

- 1/ **Disrespect Crack Arête** f4 Sit start. Layback and udge the bounding crack.
- 2/ Fresh Prince of Bail Aire f6b \* Sit start on obvious low holds below the "fresh" graffiti. Contort up the groove.

#### Other condition info:

The brambles can be rampant in Spring and Summer. The quarry feels very secluded from nearby civilisation.

## Parking and approach info:

As for Baildon Bank – see the YMC guides. The boulder is the lower quarry below the great soaring lines such as Anne of Cleaves. The Pipe Boulder is the obvious block on the left (looking in) – it had a metal pipe under it.

#### 3/ Flesh f6a+

Clamp the main side-pull on Fresh Prince and the arête. Throw for the top.

4/ **Sooty's Start** f6c+/7a Sit start on the shelf on the right face. Pull round and finish as for *Flesh*.

### 5/ Fresh Traverse f4

Traverse the top from right to left. Turning the first arête is the only challenging bit.
