Faces all directions.

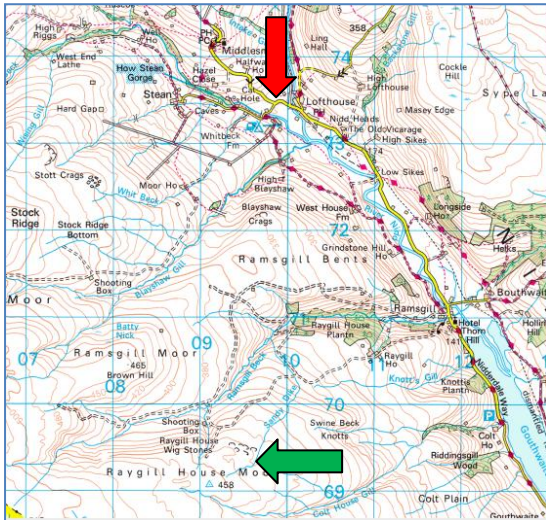
Other condition info:

A cluster of several blocks set high on the moor that provides a good day for walkers who like to boulder. It is a lovely spot. The rock is good though always likely to need a bit of a brush as there's not going to be many visits.



The problems are left for you to discover though one stand-out problem is the bulging nose of the main highest boulder – 6b ish.

Parking and approach info:



Park at the bend before the turning to Studfold/Steane (ample parking).

The approach uses footpaths and tracks above Studfold with a short section across the moorland linking these.
